



# **Scriptural Insights**

At Sychar, the disciples search for food as Jesus rests by Jacob's well. Generally, Samaritans held a Torah-centered faith focusing on the patriarchs, worshiping on Mount Gerazim, and looking for a prophet-Moses-like messiah, while Jews held to their broader scriptural tradition, including prophets, centered their worship in Jerusalem, and hoped for a messiah-king of David's line. Although sharing the same foundation, the groups shared nothing else: not food, drink, or utensils. When a Samaritan woman comes to the well for her daily water-drawing chore, the scene is set for Jesus to upend conventions and incorporate a woman who is also Samaritan into his own group of followers, reconciling long-standing divisions.

Jesus demands a drink. By seeking a drink from the woman's jar, he rejects the religious division between them from the outset, not to mention gender conventions. For her part, the woman boldly questions his behavior. Responding spiritually, Jesus presents the gift of God and living water, referencing their shared Mosaic traditions and today's Old Testament reading.

Jesus challenges her to a new relationship with God through him, hinting at the coming revelation of himself as the "I AM" of God (4:26). She first counters literally but then asks about Jacob our ancestor" and giver of the well. She is open and, more symbolically, wants to know who Jesus is in relation to their shared history. Jesus responds by challenging her to think further about what he gives: "a spring of water welling up to eternal life" (4:14).

The woman's mission is perfected in the faith of the villagers based on their encounter with Jesus: "We know that this is truly the savior of the world" (4:42). The Samaritan woman becomes both a disciple of Jesus and an apostle to her community.
